WHO ARE THE DEVIL'S AGENTS, PURPORTING TO BE REFORMERS?

In an article edited by Elder Lin Rashford of the S. D. A. Church, Port Limon, C. R. entitled "Coming Out of a Storm," and published in the Inter-American Messenger of July, 1924; which is the official organ of the Inter-American Division of the General Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists, made mention of the following:

"For the past two years the work in Costa Rica has been like a good old ship in a tremendous storm. We were almost blown away; and we lost some of our tacklings, but thank God, we are almost out of the storm, and although we still bear the marks of our encounter, our hearts are full of courage.

As in other places, the devil through his agents, purporting to be reformers, deceived quite a number of our believers, pulled down one of our churches, and took charge of another. We are glad to report, however, that at least seven from the church have re-

turned." The tremendous storm referred to by our good Elder Rashford, could be nothing else but the monster tent meeting conducted in this town by Evangelist J. W. Manns, president of the General Assembly of Free S. D. A., Savannah, Ga., in which he (Elder Rashford) had a principal part in planning for Elder Manns deportation. This tent meeting was indeed a storm to Elder Rashford, because the devil had blinded his eyes from seeing the true manifestation of the Spirit of God. For since all storms are quieted by the hand of God, then this so-called storm should have been quieted likewise. But to the contrary, we saw Elder Rashford and his broods, with the aid of some unscrupulous officials make a concocted plot, and had him illegally deported from Costa Rica in order to cease the storm. Walls of partitions are being built up in the very house of God. In the Colon Church of S. D. A. on the Isthmus of

Panama, a few benches on the right side of the church are specially made for white people These benches are the most comfortable in the church. One time a certain colored brother realizing that there should be no distinction in the house of God, went and sat down in one of them. He was immediately dispersed in a very tyrannical way, and was finally made a subject to

church discipline.

At a later date the devil inspired them to sever their connections from the negro church, and worship in the Pacific Press where they will only see white faces. And when some of the most intelligent negroes demanded the reason for such division, they declared to them this flimsy phrase, "We worship in the Press to gain white people." But ah! the sentiment was so strong and as all their support is from the negro, without gaining one single white individual, they were seen hurrying back with their faces under their wings. What more hellish actions could be exercised by professed Christians than this? Is not the devil using (white) S. D. A. as his agents? also the negroes that link with them?

The Seventh-day Adventist church has become united with the world to the extent that in the laying of the corner-stone of their church, ungodly men were used to perform such sacred work,-which work only the priest or family of the priest should be entrusted to accomplish. For thus saith the Lord, Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying Grace, grace unto it. If they were belonging to the conference, why did they not take them over, when the conference sent Elder Sype up and down in the court houses of San Jose and Siquirres? And withal spent hundreds of dollars to obtain them. But alas! his efforts proved an ignominious failure. For the Judges told him that the builders of the churches must claim them.

Elder Rashford boasted that seven from the church have returned. But I say unto you those seven are just like you. We are not sorry to rid the church of them. AN EDITORIAL

A Word to the Negro Ministry of the Seventh-Day Adventist Denomination

If our Negro S. D. A. ministers had self-respect, they could compel the respect of others. As long as they are willing to be the menials and servants and slaves of our white leading S. D. A. brethren, that is what they will be.

Negro Adventists should realize that there are several thousands of them in the S. D. A. Organization. And what future does the denomination offer them? You must sacrifice all of your self-respect to remain in it. But if you will unite and stand together and be true to each other, you will develop an influence that will demand respect, of every white Seventhday Adventist, leaders included.

You as ministers go as delegates to the local union, and General Conferences, but what do you accomplish? You never have a programme. No three of you Negro ministers agree. As long as you are unorganized—as long as you are indifferent, as long as you are satisfied to remain in the organization mostly for little salary you are receiving and keep our Negro members in ignorance you will invite contempt and receive it, but when you rise in the majesty of your Christian manhood and womanhood, close up the ranks and stand together, you will command respect and consideration and you will receive it from

the leaders of the S. D. A. denomination, but not until then.

Now, if you still persist-you my Negro brethren in the ministry—in remaining where you are in this organization which offers you, nor your sons and daughters nothing, no, not even, as a rule, a job as floor sweeper in any of its publishing houses, tract societies, conference offices or sanitariums, you are stultifying yourselves; you are insulting your race; you are barring the door in your own faces, the door that leads to Freedom of thinking and acting according to the dictates of your own conscience. The time has come for you to realize what your position is in the Seventh-day Adventist denomination.

The Methodists, Baptists, the Seventh-day Adventists and the rest are all just about alike in the treatment they accord their Negro membership. There is no difference between Seventh-day Adventists and the others. challenge anybody anywhere, white or black, to show me the between slightest difference them, except it be in favor of the Methodists or Baptists.

TO THE MEMBERS OF OUR CHURCHES

Do You Know Why You Are Free Seventh-Day Adventists? Commit to Memoru the Following Reasons

We, Free Seventh-day Adventists, believe all the fundamental principles of the doctrines as were taught by the founders of the Seventh-day Adventists denomination.

Second. We are free because it is not Christian to estimate men by their outward appearance, nor by their color. Acts 17:26. 2 Sam. 14:14.

Third. Because birth, nationality, color, nor station do not elevate nor degrade men. Acts 10:26-35.

Fourth. Because we accept the Bible alone as our supreme rule of faith and practice. 2 Tim. 3:16, 17, and we accept only such other writings as harmonize with the Word of God. Isa. 8:20.

Fifth. Because the Lord is that Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 2 Cor. 3:17.

Sixth. Because we respect not the person of men, but condescend to high and low. Rom. 12:16. James 2:5-9.

Seventh. Because we are working and praying to realize that promise, "All are one in Christ." Gal. 3:27-28.

Eighth. Because we plead for freedom in Christ for each and every one. Free to think, to believe and act as the Word and Spirit of God shall direct. Ex. 5:1.

This is in harmony with the teaching of Sister E. G. White, from the Church Officers Gazette, No. 2, Vol. 3, page 5, issue of February, 1916. quote:

Freedom in Thought.—"Ye

were now turned, and had done right in proclaiming liberty every man to his neighbor." 34:15. "What should man do? What should we not allow? Allow no one to be brain for you, allow no one to do your thinking, your investigating and your praying. This is the instruction that we need to take to heart today." "Special Testimonies on Education," page 193. What belongs to every individ-"There are rights which belong to every individual. We have an individuality and an identity that is our own. No man can submerge his identity into that of any other. All must act for themselves, according to the dictates of their own conscience." "Special Testimonies to Ministers and Workers." No. 9, page 59.

Many minds are in bondage through laziness, others through fear of men. Others through admiration of ability of some individuals; others through superstition and still others through the lack of individual accountability. During the centuries that have gone, men have lost much because of this bondage: and at the present they are losing much from the same evil. In the world there are but few who think for themselves.'

It is the privilege of all men to be free from fear of their fellow men. Isa. 8:12, 13. 51:12,

Ninth. We are free because the white leaders of the Seventhday Adventists denomination against colored discriminate people. They do this abominable, most detestable, discriminating in the organization, the Church, the office, the school and sanitarium, notwithstanding the Negro membership must make great sacrifices to aid in building up these wonderful institutions now owned by the S. D. A. denomination.

Tenth. We are free because Negro Seventh-day Adventists, as a rule, are barred from Seventh-day Adventists Northern and Western schools, where schools of the world make no distinction among the races.

Eleventh. We are free because the white leaders of the Seventh-day Adventists denomination bar even Negro Seventhday Adventists patients from their sanitariums, when the worldly institutions of the same kind, accept colored people of every walk of life.

Twelfth. We are free, because Negro Seventh-day Adventists are barred from holding any clerical position in the Seventh-day Adventists Publishing houses, tract societies and conference offices.

When the white leaders of Seventh-day Adventists questioned about these fictitious rules and laws, and demanded to give reason for their existence, like PANTHERS shout, "Because of the prejudice of the unconverted white people against our denomination." But this, we have proved to be a lie of their own manufacturing.

There is more prejudice in the Seventh-day Adventists Church against the Negro than what is to be found in any other denomination under heaven. The prejudice existing in this professed commandment keeping Church would shame the Papacy, and make the devil blush.

Are we to be condemned because we will not submit to such treatment measured to us at the hands of a professed Christian organization? Shall we hold our peace, and mourn: LEAVE IT TO THE LORD? I answer no, in the loudest tone. In Isa. 58: 1, we read: "Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins."

"For among my people are found wicked men: they lay wait as he that setteth snares: they set a trap, they catch men. . . The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means: and my people love to have it so." Jer. 5:26.

There are hundreds of Negroes yet in the Seventh-day Adventists denomination know, and have been burnt by the heat, but fearing they will commit a sin against the Holy Ghost, they hold their peace and sigh: "LEAVE IT TO THE LORD." They well know that if they dare speak against such malpractices of these leaders, out they must go. I spoke openly against the evils, namely, prejudice, discrimination and Negro proscription. But I did it at cost of my position as a minister in the denomination.

Thus, is fulfilled the prophecy of Isa. 66:5: "Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, let the Lord be glorified, but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed."

Having been cast out, not out of the Lamb's Book of Life; no, no, but out of the S. D. A. Conference Book, we are determined, with the pure religion, and undefiled before God, our Father, to "stand fast in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free." Gal. 5:1.

ARE THE LAODICEANS SPUED OUT?

That the Seventh-day Adventists (the Laodiceans of Rev. 3: 14) are apostates, any one with spiritual understanding who reads the message to that church in Rev. 3:14-17 can easthat ily see. And in reading the writings of Sister E. G. White, both the testimonies to the church and others of her productions, one's eyes cannot help seeing in nearly every paragraph some very startling statements relative to the extent to which that church has departed from God.

Apostate Experience.

It is also obvious by reading the seven messages to the seven churches in Rev. from Chapters 1-3 that the apostasy of the Seventh-day Adventist or Laodiceans, is to be the last state of an apostate or backslidden experience through which the true church of God will pass, from since the apostolic times. And the Seventh-day Adventists as an organization or church locally, will never be reformed, and Jesus will come and find her in the same apostate condition as any of her predecessors. As a proof read the following state-"Are we hoping to see ment: the whole church revived? That time will never come. . . . We must enter upon the work individually." Sister Ellen G. White Review and Herald, March 22, 1887.

Apostasy Compared.

Of all backslidden experiences through which the true church of God has passed in other ages, the Seventh-day Adventists are the worst. Proof Sister White stated in Test., Vol. 1, p. 129, like this: "I saw that many (not a few) who profess to believe the truth for these last days, think it strange that the children of Doreal murmured as they journeyed; that after the wonderful dealings of God with them they should be so ungrateful as to forget what he had done for them. Said the angel, ye are worse than they."

The Sin of Ancient Israel.

Why, then, is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? They hold fast deceit, they refuse to return. . . . Behold the Word of the Lord was unto them a reproach: they have no delight in it. Jer. 8:5, 6:10. "The sin of ancient Israel was in disregarding the expressed will of God and follow their own way according to the leadings of unsatisfied hearts. Modern Israel (the Seventh-day Adventist Organization) are fast following in their footsteps." Test., Vol. 5:94.

The History of Ancient Israel. The history of ancient Israel will give us a clear idea of what God will do to the Seventh-day Adventist (Modern Israel) if they are following in Ancient Israel's footsteps. For the Apostle Paul would have us to "all that these understand things happened to them for examples (or types, margin) and they are written for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world are come." 2 Cor. 10:11. Is Ancient Israel rejected as a nation or a church? I almost hear every one reading this question say yes. Well, why were they rejected? Because of their disregard for the expressed will of God. But we may consider three stages which ended in their complete rejection by God. First the Spirit of God withdrawn. And as a consequence their leaders became blind so that when Jesus came He said they were blind leaders leading the blind. Matt. 15:12: 14; Isaiah 56:10. Reader, if you were in Jesus' days would you believe that such men were really blind? Men of culture, refinement, education, strictly moral? The second stage in the rejection of that well or-

ganized Jewish Church was the Divine presence withdrawn. Said the Lord through Jeremiah: "I have forsaken mine house: I have left mine heritage. I have given the dearly beloved of my soul into the hands of her Many pastors have enemies. destroyed my vineyard: they have trodden my portion under foot: they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilder-Jer. 12:7, 10. Jesus ness.' stated thus concerning it: "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets and stonest them which are sent unto thee: how often would I have gathered thy children together as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings and ye would not. Behold your house is left unto you desolate. Ye shall not see me until the time come when ye shall say Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord." Luke 13:34, 35. In the Sabbath School Quarterly for 1925, in the fourth quarter, lesson 12, note 4, December 19th, 1925, is the following statement found: "Your house." "Jesus does not now speak of it as my house. It was once the Lord's temple, God's own house. He dwelt over the Mercy Seat between the Cherubims. His glory, the holy Sheltinah lighted all its rooms. There He spoke to His priests in guiding and giving the nation counsel. To it the nation looked when they remember the God of all the earth. But Jesus now says: "Your temple," your house, to intimate that God had abandoned it and would dwell in it no more forever. So in 2 Chron. 36:17, when He delivered the temple into the hand of the Chaldeans—the house of your Sanctuary. A similar form of speech is found in Ex. 32:7, where the Lord said to Moses: "Thy people," to intimate that He acknowledged them no longer for His followers. The last and final rejection was when they stoned Stephen, A. D. 34.

Now if the Seventh-day Adventists are following the footsteps of Ancient Israel we have the revelation from the unerring testimony that they have long ago passed the first, second, and it is left with you, reader, to decide after I shall have presented the facts in the case, whether the Laodiceans (Seventh-day Adventists) are not entirely

spued out, rejected, or according to Webster, "cast forth with abhorrence."

Seventh-day Adventists disregard for the expressed will of God.

That the Seventh-day Adventists have disregarded the expressed will of God is evident from the earliest writing of the prophetess. Proof: "The solemn testimony upon which the destiny of the Church hangs has been lightly esteemed if not entirely disregarded." Early writing 270. This is a startling statement, isn't it? And if there was not another of its kind found anywhere else in her writings, this should make the conscientious sit up and think. But Seventh-day Adventists like Ancient Israel do not believe. I have stated before them that, from what was shown me, but a small number of those now professing to believe the truth would eventually be saved,—not because they could not be saved but because they would not be saved in God's own appointed way." Test. 2:445. Indeed, these are startling statements, but they do not believe it. "And it came to pass, that when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking unto all the people all the words of the Lord their God, for which the Lord their God had sent him unto them, even all these words. Then spake Anzariah, the son of Hoshiah, and Johanan, the son of Kaveah, and all the proud men, saying unto Jeremiah, thou speakest falsely: the Lord our God hath not sent thee to say, Go not into Egypt to sojourn there. But Baruch, the son of Neriah, setteth thee on against us, for to deliver us into the hand of the Chaldeans, that they might put us to death, and carry us away captives into Babylon." Jer. 43:1-3.
